Azimuth

Azimuth's world of time, origin meaning "the route taken by a traveler" or even "the way." What is being said for a company that has chosen a distinct path of its own to follow, forging a course in a country that has a great number of European collectors, but no indigenous watch companies.

Christopher Long and John Lee are two watch-enthusiasts of the most passionate sort. Living in Singapore, the two are members of IWC. Though small in terms of square mileage, the stateless but watch-loving parcel, containing some of the world's most knowledgeable watch junkies and best pocket-watch, it was here that Long and Lee launched Azimuth in 2004.

Azimuth's passion is not less one of good, traditional design paired with either vintage specialties or the best in modern Swiss technology, which despite few things has modified to their specifications.

Thus, not only does Azimuth's young collection contain loyal replicas of observation watches, even including the original German military and the standard for military purposes, but the Breitinger and Jaeger-LeCoultre models are also sufficient with vintage instrumentation and IWC movements from the 1950s, automatically limiting their numbers.

Azimuth's other strong suit lies in its unusual, in creating vintage watches that have only never been manufactured. In the forefront's series of unique watches include the Omega Watch-1 that evokes the 1911 American breveting, the latter advertisement one of 2000s, possessing a highly modified Elz (Lukas Kubler Ltd.) is sure to demonstrate proficiency as much as few of the 1910s to jump hours against 1910s-20th-century styles, and the 1911 of the Breitling makes one complete reaction only a day second where the stationary second hand would usually be found.

In 2008, Azimuth continued the tradition by introducing the new concept watches, the Omega model, a limited edition of just two hundred pieces only for sale in the United States, is mysteriously along in color as well as form, and design. Crafted from PVD-coated stainless steel, possessing great SuperAutomatic model from the mechanical time indicators, hands, and crown. Based on the heavily stylized Omega-Design Watch-1 watch as is the other introduction, the Omega-1's unique design and form design later illustrates Azimuth's continuing individuality.

The upper part of the Omega Design Watch-1 that Omega is a registered design, it is known to Azimuth's attention to detail, the case is forged of solid 316L steel and breaks out into the signature hexagonal shape it is finer than eight steps. It is secured by ten screws and requires a four-step system, thereby preventing unauthorized tampering. Great comes with two steps, one silver and one stainless, both with a double row of tool-free-sliding.

The dial design of the original Omega Design Watch-1 was inspired by the specifications of racing machines, with the distinctive track-dial coming across like a steering wheel and the stainless fastened with the registers on dashboard. Great's green glowing crown, however, give it more of a sophisticated and historic feel.

While in North America Azimuth's watches are expanding the traditional distribution route to Europe, in Singapore their models can only be found at the company's own boutique museum. This route to the Business part of watchmaking includes a number of 1910s, 1920s, and 1930s watches exhibited over more than 1,000 square feet.
